

Adjustment sweet Lola

With the pattern of Lola Ladybug as base you can also grab a hook.

These are the adjustments of the wings and the angel:



Material

Approx 50 grams Phildar Coton 3, black

Approx 25 grams Phildar Coton 3, yellow

Approx 30 grams Phildar Coton 3, off white

Approx 25 grams fluffy yarn, off white

8 mm black safety eyes

2,5 mm and 3,5 mm crochet hook

Synthetic filling

Used stitches

ch = chain

sl.st = slip stitch

sc = single crochet

sc2tog = single crochet two

stitches together

WING (MAKE 2)

Crochet the wings with fluffy yarn and Phildar Coton 3 together and a 3,5 mm crochet hook.

Crochet 2ch

1. 6sc in the last chain from the hook
2. 2sc in each sc, repeat (12sc)
3. 1sc, 2sc in the next sc, repeat (18sc)
4. 2sc, 2sc in the next sc, repeat (24sc)
5. 3sc, 2sc in the next sc, repeat (30sc)
- 6-10. 30sc
11. 3sc, sc2tog, repeat (24sc)
- 12-15. 24sc
16. 2sc, sc2tog, repeat (18sc)
- 17-18. 18sc
19. 1sc, sc2tog, repeat (12sc)
- 20-21. 12sc

Fold the wing and close with 6sc.

Sew the wings together and attach them to the body.

STING

Crochet with black.

Crochet 2ch

1. 6sc in the last chain from the hook
2. 6sc
3. 1sc, 2sc in the next sc, repeat (9sc)
4. 9sc
5. 2sc, 2sc in the next sc, repeat (12sc)
6. 12sc

7. 3sc, 2sc in the next sc, repeat (15sc)

8. 15sc

9. 4sc, 2sc in the next sc, repeat (18sc)

10. 18sc

Sew the sting at the back of the body.
